

INTRODUCTION TO THE New Zealand HEALTH INDUSTRY CERTIFICATE

- WHO** This certificate course will benefit anyone working in or new to the health sector, specifically:
- New pharmaceutical sales representatives
 - Experienced pharmaceutical sales representatives new to NZ
 - Experienced pharmaceutical sales representatives requiring a Hawker's Licence
- WHY** Gain comprehensive understanding and up to date working knowledge of structures and ethics of the healthcare industry
- Understand the implications of current health legislation.
 - Understand how economics is applied to the health sector
 - Obtain a Hawkers Licence without further study and MoH examination
- WHEN**
- Distance Learning Course allows flexibility of starting as soon as enrolment received
 - Suggested completion time of 6 months
 - Total time spent on the course should not exceed 50 hours
- WHAT** The course was developed and is updated and administered by Synergy Training & Development Ltd. It is endorsed by the RMI and the New Zealand College of Pharmacists.

Obtaining a Hawkers Licence

Upon successful completion of Module One, the Legislation Module, applicants will receive a letter confirming their pass. To receive the licence they need to make an appointment at the Ministry of Health Regional Licensing Office for a brief (non testing) interview. They will need to produce the letter proving their pass, and a character reference.
